Dear Mosinee Resident:

I hope you are enjoying summer. I am happy to bring you this monthly update from City Hall.

At our July Common Council meeting, the Council approved a final plat for the Jackson Woods Subdivision. This subdivision is located on a 7.7 acre parcel off of Oconto Road. The plat proposes to add 19 single-family residential lots ranging from 11,882 square feet to 19,779 square feet in size. We are excited about the possibility of these additional residential opportunities for new residents looking to become part of our community. Over the past several years, we have seen considerable new single and multi-family developments in Mosinee, including in the areas of Stone Ridge Drive and Maple Ridge Road.

In other business at our July Common Council meeting, the Council approved the installation of parklets on Third Street at the newly renovated property at the corner of Third and Main Streets. Parklets are partially enclosed, open air structures that allow for outdoor seating during summer months. The owner hopes to incorporate these into his new business venture at that location.

In other news,I am happy to announce that the City will be receiving a \$26,000 grant toward a lighting upgrade at the local softball field. The lighting system is very outdated and in need of a complete upgrade. Together with funds from the softball association, the upgrade is anticipated for this season. Thanks to the generous contribution from the grant, the City will be able to preserve its Parks and Recreation budget for other projects, including the eventual development of a new park in the Maple Ridge area where residential development continues to expand.

At our July meeting, we received a report from our new Police Chief, Ken Grams. Chief Grams provided us with an update on his department's investigation into a burglary at the golf course and a nearby neighborhood theft. The investigation is ongoing and we hope to have an update on efforts to identify those involved in the near future.

Turning to public works news, for residents using Second Street between the Post Office and Third Street, you will notice that the City has permanently closed that section of Second Street by Pine Street. The closure was intended to decrease excessive speeds by vehicles using this stretch of street and creating safety concerns for pedestrians and residents in the neighborhood.

In closing, I want to remind residents that with the pleasant months of summer come complaints of property maintenance issues from weeds to inoperable vehicles to a host of other issues. Please remember that you can report these issues to the City anonymously online through our See Click Fix program. The City has a code enforcement officer dedicated to addressing these and other complaints.

I want to wish you and your families a pleasant close to the summer. As always, should you have any comments, questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me at City Hall. I look forward to updating you again next month.

## BRUSH PICKUP SERVICE

The City of Mosinee provides brush pickup service for City residents.

The brush must be cut into lengths less than 6' long and piled neatly.

Any brush that has roots attached will not be picked up.

Brush will not be picked up for residents that are clearing a lot. Brush and tree limbs are picked up the third week of each month.

To have your brush picked up, call 715-693-3840, before the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday, leave your name, address, and location of the branches.
