Spring Election – Tuesday, April 7th

The Spring Election will be held on Tuesday, April 7th, 2020.

Polls open at 7:00a.m. and close at 8:00p.m.

Where to Vote:

- District 1 – Wards 1,2, 6 and 7 City Hall – 225 Main Street
- District 2 – Ward 3, 4 and 5 WI National Guard Armory – 1000 Jackson St

Sample ballots will be available for viewing on our City website. Absentee ballots are available for anyone that is unwilling or unable to vote at the poll site locations on Election Day. Applications for absentee ballots are available at City Hall and on our website (www.mosinee.wi.us)

If you have moved or changed your name since the last time you voted, you will be required to update your voter registration form. You may do this on election day or you can stop at City Hall and update your registration prior to the election.

NOTICE – DOG/CAT OWNER

Dogs and Cats are required to be licensed by March 31st, 2020. The license period runs from January 1st, 2020 to December 31st, 2020. State law requires that all dogs must be licensed yearly AND City ordinances require cats to be licensed yearly. Before a license can be issued, you must furnish a rabies vaccination certificate to show proof of vaccination against rabies.

CITY ADMINISTRATOR REPORT - MARCH 2020

At the March 4, 2020 meeting, the City's Plan Commission reviewed the proposed construction of a sports training facility at the intersection of South View Drive at Golf Club Boulevard in the Central Wisconsin Business Park (CWBP). The owners of *Crystal Finishing Systems, Inc. (Mark & Laurie Matthiae)* would like to construct the proposed 30,000 s.f. facility in the southeast corner of *Crystal Finishing's* manufacturing & professional office use property. The intent of the specialized sports training facility is to "*provide a reduced cost sports training facility that will be open to the public along with private groups, including schools, teams and individuals of all ages from primarily 3 years and older*". It was the consensus of the Plan Commission that the proposed facility would benefit our community and the Commission unanimously passed a motion to recommend that the City Common Council approve the proposed sports training facility plans with conditions.

The Plan Commission also reviewed a conceptual plan to complete the development of the remaining approximate 19.4-acres of the Stone Ridge Subdivision that is located on the north end of Indianhead Drive (adjacent to the Indianhead Golf Course). The conceptual development plan for the First Addition (2nd Phase) of the subdivision proposed the addition of five (5) single-family lots on the east end of Fairway Drive and ten (10) single-family lots on the east end of Stone Ridge Drive. The Commission advised the property owner (*Richard Austin*) to proceed with preparing formal plans pertaining to the development of the remaining lots in the subdivision for the City's consideration in the future.

The Plan Commission also reviewed a conceptual development plan for the approximate 15.1-acre vacant parcel that is located on the north side of Maple Ridge Road (between the Maple Ridge Estates apartments and the new River View on Maple Ridge Subdivision). *A&D Contractors* of Weston, WI is proposing to develop twenty (20) 6-unit rental townhouses (120 units total) and one (1) 36-unit apartment building on the parcel as a Planned Unit Development (PUD). The Commission expressed concerns to the developer regarding the proposed density of the development and the need for proper buffering from the adjacent single-family residential uses.

I would like to encourage all residents and businesses to play an active role in your community by discussing any matter you feel should be addressed by your local government, with the Mayor, a City Council member or myself.
