Spring Election – Tuesday, April 6th

The Spring Election will be held on Tuesday, April 6th, 2021.

Polls open at 7:00a.m. and close at 8:00p.m.

Where to Vote:

- District 1 – Wards 1,2, 6 and 7 City Hall – 225 Main Street
- District 2 – Ward 3, 4 and 5 WI National Guard Armory – 1000 Jackson St

Sample ballots will be available for viewing on our City website. Absentee ballots are available for anyone that is unwilling or unable to vote at the poll site locations on Election Day. Applications for absentee ballots are available at City Hall and on our website (www.mosinee.wi.us)

If you have moved or changed your name since the last time you voted, you will be required to update your voter registration form. You may do this on election day or you can stop at City Hall and update your registration prior to the election.

NOTICE – DOG/CAT OWNER

Dogs and Cats are required to be licensed by March 31st, 2021. The license period runs from January 1st, 2021 to December 31st, 2021. State law requires that all dogs must be licensed yearly AND City ordinances require cats to be licensed yearly. Before a license can be issued, you must furnish a rabies vaccination certificate to show proof of vaccination against rabies.

- New -S/F Residences, Duplexes, Apartments
- Commercial Buildings
- Additions
- Upgrades to electrical & plumbing services
- Garages and sheds
- Interior Remodeling (new walls, bathroom upgrades, kitchen upgrades, finishing basement, etc)
- Siding
- Decks, Patios, Porches
- Fences, Driveways, and Swimming pools
- Moving existing buildings into the City
- Roofs – (No charge for permit – permit required / Metal roof materials not allowed)

Building Permits are not required in the City of Mosinee for the following projects:

- Replacement of Windows, Doors
