BRUSH PICKUP SERVICE

The City of Mosinee provides brush pickup service for City residents. The brush must be cut into lengths less than 6' long and piled neatly.

Any brush that has roots attached will not be picked up.

Brush will not be picked up for residents that are clearing a lot. Brush and tree limbs are picked up the third week of the month.

To have your brush picked up, call 715-693-3840 before the 3rd Monday. Please leave your name, address and location of the branches.



YARD WASTE DISPOSAL SITE

The City of Mosinee Yard Waste site is open. The Yard Waste site is located @ 202 Fremont Street near Chuck's Boat Landing. Please only use this site for dropping off: Leaves, Grass Clippings, Hedge Trimmings, Garden Refuse, etc.

Please do not drop off: :

Brush, Tree limbs, Christmas trees, Stumps, or any other garbage at this site.

AUTO-PAY YOUR WATER/SEWER BILL

Recycle Electrical Cords & Christmas Lights

Habitat for Humanity of Wausau is collecting Electrical cords and Christmas lights. Every year tons of light strings are thrown away and end up in landfills across the country. Habitat for Humanities collects all kinds of light strings – old or new, working or not. Worn out/cut extension cords are also collected. BUILDING PERMITS ARE REQUIRED FOR THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS:

The following projects require a building permit:

- New Construction: Single Family House, Duplex, Apartment, Commercial, or Manufacturing Buildings
- Additions to existing buildings,
- Upgrades to electrical / plumbing services,
- Garages / Sheds,
- Interior remodeling (new walls, bathroom & kitchen upgrades, finishing basement, etc),
- Siding
- Roof (no charge for permit permit required)
- Decks, Patios, Porches,
- Fences,
- Swimming Pools (Greater than 18" deep), Driveways,
- Moving buildings into/thru City.

PETS IN CITY

We receive numerous complaints of dogs being walked throughout the City, in city parks and on our recreation trail that are not on leashes. We also receive complaints about owners not picking up after their dogs.

When walking your pet in public areas, please remember that your dog, must be on a leash at all times.

Please also remember, Section 10-6 of our City Ordinances also states that owners or persons in charge of any dog or other animal shall not permit solid fecal matter of such animal to be deposited on any street, alley, sidewalk, walking trail, city park, boat landing, ballfield (softball, baseball and soccer) or other public or private property, unless such matter is immediately removed therefrom by said owner or person in charge. The City has numerous Pet Pal Stations throughout the City which contain bags that pet owners can use to pick up after their dogs.

A reminder - ONLY TWO PETS ARE ALLOWED PER CITY ORDINANCES – TWO DOGS, TWO CATS, OR ONE DOG & ONE CAT. YEARLY LICENSES ARE REQUIRED AND MAY BE OBTAINED AT CITY HALL.
